*This code of conduct is a set of guidelines designed to safeguard and ensure the safe practice of the activities of this club.*

## 1. **Introduction**

The Linux Users Group (LUG) considers it good practice to operate in accordance with the following guidelines.

This code of conduct will be available to anyone wishing to read it in the Imperial College Union Resource Centre.

## 2. **Union Activities**

Union Activities are recognised as being any event which is

- (a) Publicised at the LUG meetings, announced on the ic-linux-list mailing list by a currently elected member of the LUG committee, or advertised on college noticeboards by an officially approved poster.
- (b) Funded to any degree by the Union, or requires the use of equipment owned by the LUG or by the Union, or of transport booked through the Union.

## 3. **Responsibilities of Committee Members**

To ensure that LUG members act in a responsible way, and the LUG is not brought into disrepute through the actions of its members.

To be aware of the location of convenient First Aid facilities in case of emergency.

#### 4. **Members' Responsibilities**

To act responsibly during any LUG activities, and not to bring the LUG, Recreational Clubs Committee or Imperial College Union into disrepute.
